- Dreams confirm a prophetic word
 - o 2 Peter 1:16-21 "You do well to heed as a light"

Message

1. Why does God use dreams?
 - a. Gen. 20:3,14
 - b. Gen. 41:1,43
 - c. Job 33:14-17 "Conceal Pride"
 - d. Prov. 25:2 "Who's Glory?"
2. God used Nebuchadnezzar's dream to:
 - a. "Expose false power"
 - i. Vs. 9 "to speak lying and corrupt words"
 - ii. Vs. 11 "Except the gods"

Note: God concealed the matter

3. There was "no private interpretation" I Peter 1:20
 - a. Vs. 17 Made known to companions
 - b. Vs. 18 Sought God's mercies (Also I Kings 3:9,11)

Note: God has tested in Chapter 1. He answers us based on what is motivating our hearts.

4. The Interpretation Prov. 15:23
5. God positions His servants
 - a. "But Daniel sat in the gate of the king" (Also Acts 9:15)

Application: God tests us so that we can be trusted when He positions us to where we are called.
